Numbers Chapter 11 בְּמִדְבַּר

- א וַיְהִי הָעָם כְּמִתְאַנְנִים, רַע בְּאַזְנֵי יְהוָה; וַיִּשְׁמַע יְהוָה, וַיַּחַר אַפּוֹ, וַתִּבְעַר-בָּם אֵשׁ יְהוָה, וַתֹּאכַל בְּקִצָּה הַמַּחֲנֶה.
- The people took to complaining bitterly before the Lord. The Lord heard and was incensed: a fire of the Lord broke out against them, ravaging the outskirts of the camp.
- ב וַיִּצְעַק הָעָם, אֶל-מֹשֶׁה; וַיִּתְפַּלֵּל מֹשֶׁה אֶל-יְהוָה, וַתִּשְׁקַע הָאֵשׁ.
- 2 And **the people cried unto Moses**; and **Moses prayed unto the LORD**, and the fire died down.
- ג וַיִּקְרָא שֵׁם-הַמָּקוֹם הַהוּא, תַּבְּעֵרָה: כִּי-בְעָרָה בָּם, אֵשׁ יְהוָה.
- 3 And the name of that place was called Taberah, because the fire of the LORD had broken out against them.
- ד וְהָאִסְפָּסֹף אֲשֶׁר בְּקִרְבּוֹ, הִתְאַוּוּ תַאֲוָה; וַיִּשְׁבוּ וַיִּבְכּוּ, גַּם בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל, וַיֹּאמְרוּ, מִי יֹאכְלֵנוּ בָּשָׂר.
- 4 The riffraff in their midst felt a gluttonous craving; and then the Israelites wept and said, 'If only we had **meat** to eat!
- ה זָכְרֵנוּ, אֶת-הַדָּגָה, אֲשֶׁר-נֹאכַל בְּמִצְרַיִם, חֲנֹם; אֵת הַקִּשְׁאִים, וְאֵת הָאֲבִטְחִים, וְאֵת-הַחֲצִיר וְאֵת-הַבְּצָלִים, וְאֵת-הַשּׁוּמִים.
- 5 We **remember** the fish, which we used to eat in Egypt, the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlic;
- ו וְעַתָּה נַפְשֵׁנוּ יִבֶּשֶׁה, אֵין כֹּל--בְּלִתֵּי, אֶל-הַמָּן עֵינֵינוּ.
- 6 Now our souls are shriveled. There is nothing at all! Nothing but this **manna** to look to!
